Wednesday – Household/Trash Items and Refuse, Brush, Yard Waste

Collection of Refuse & Yard Waste

The Town collects refuse and yard waste, incidental to normal weekly garbage collection provided that it is placed at the curb and does not exceed the maximum size and length requirements. Leaves, trimmings and clippings should be placed in boxes, garbage bags or other types of plastic bags to prevent the wind from blowing waste into the street. Brush and tree limbs should have a maximum length of no more than 6 feet. **Please place brush, tree limbs, bags, grass clippings and like items at the curb and NOT in the street.** Brush, refuse and yard waste of such size and/or amount that it constitutes a truck load (equal to or greater than 7 cubic yards) will not be removed until Public Works is contacted at 548-6041 to make arrangements for removal. Property owners will be responsible for County Landfill and tipping fees for yard waste that constitutes or exceeds a truck load.

The following will **NOT** be picked up by the Town:

- Aluminum cans
- hazardous waste
- animal carcasses
- shingles
- commercial waste
- industrial waste
- appliances
- barrels and drums
- antifreeze
- pressurized containers
- auto batteries
- whole scrap tires
- scrap metal
- asbestos
- demolition or construction materials
- used oil
- liquids
- paint

White Goods Removal

The Town's Public Works Department will remove and dispose of white good items from your property for a fee of \$10.00 per item. White goods are described as appliances such as stoves, refrigerators, washers, and like items. In order to have these items removed, the property owner will need to fill out a consent form and pay their \$10.00 fee to the Finance Department at Town Hall.
