Curbside Leaf Collection will begin

Monday, November 4, 2024 and end February 3, 2025

Please follow these few simple steps to ensure leaves are removed in timely manner:

- Please place your leaves behind the curb as shown in picture marked “perfect” below.
- DO NOT rake leaves into the street as this clogs stormdrains and impedes traffic.
- DO NOT park vehicles or place items in front of/on leaves as our trucks are unable to reach.
- The truck is designed to remove leaves only. DO NOT mix sticks, rocks or other debris with leaves as this will damage the truck and stop removal for everyone.
- The leaf truck runs on a route beginning near Gene Hairston St and covering the area between Gene Hairston and E/W Decatur St, it then goes to the North side of Town before moving towards the center of Town south of W. Decatur St. to south of Academy St and finally, East to West along Academy Street including streets to the South and North of Island Drive. This is a repetitive route, meaning they complete the full route and start over again. So, know that if the Town removes your leaves on X day and you immediately put more leaves out, they will complete their route before your leaves are removed again.

We request your patience when we begin leaf collection as the initial removal is typically heavy and will take additional time. Be assured that we will remove your leaves. On collection ending day, February 3, 2025, please have all loose leaves to the curb by 7:00 am. after which time all leaves must be bagged for removal. We thank you in advance for your patience and for following the steps above to ensure a smooth leaf collection season.
